**Subject:** **Resolution: Updated Intergovernmental Agreement with the ETSB for additional dispatch responsibilities**

**Background:** This Intergovernmental Agreement updates the current agreement between the City of O'Fallon and the Emergency Telephone Systems Board with regard to providing emergency dispatch services. The agreement adds responsibility for dispatching for Shiloh Police and providing transfer of calls received by our PSAP for the East Side FPD to our current PSAP agreement. We will receive the initial 911 calls for East Side because the majority of their service areas are in the Village limits of Shiloh and 911 calls are routed by law enforcement jurisdiction. Our responsibility will be to transfer the Fire calls to the County dispatch center.

**Legal Considerations, if any:** St. Clair County has already signed the agreement and the City Attorney has reviewed and approved.

**Budget Impact:** Positive revenue opportunities exist when we begin dispatching for Shiloh and this appears to be the last step necessary to make that happen.

**Staff recommendation:** Approval.
