

CITY OF O'FALLON, ILLINOIS
RESOLUTION 2010 -

AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO AN UPDATED INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT WITH THE ST. CLAIR COUNTY ETSB FOR THE PURPOSE OF PROVIDING ADDING RESPONSIBILITY FOR DISPATCHING FOR SHILOH PD AND TRANSFER RESPONSIBILITY FOR EAST SIDE FIRE DEPARTMENT TO THE CURRENT AGREEMENT

WHEREAS, the City of O'Fallon and the St. Clair County ETSB are authorized and empowered by Article VII, Section 10 of the Constitution of the State of Illinois and 5 ILCS 220/1 et seq., to enter into intergovernmental agreements, for any purpose, not prohibited by law; and

WHEREAS, the City of O'Fallon operates a Public Safety Answering Point and emergency dispatch center with sufficient capacity to provide police dispatch for the Village of Shiloh and to transfer calls for the East Side FPD that will be routed to the appropriate PSAP ; and

WHEREAS, the current agreement in place with the ETSB does not describe or cover these additions to the responsibilities assigned to the O'Fallon PSAP'; and

WHEREAS, this Intergovernmental Agreement is necessary to bring the O'Fallon PSAP into compliance with State law and ETSB rules and regulations; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF O'FALLON, ST. CLAIR COUNTY, ILLINOIS AS FOLLOWS:

That the City of O'Fallon authorizes the Mayor to enter into an Intergovernmental Agreement with the St. Clair County ETSB to update the responsibilities of the O'Fallon PSAP.
