Subject: RESOLUTION – Seven Hills Road Public Safety Building Area Sidewalk Extension

List of committees that have reviewed: None

Background: There is currently no sidewalk between the Public Safety Building to the section of sidewalk constructed by the developer of the Estates at Prairie Crossing just south of Wesley Drive on the west side of Seven Hills Road. The proposed stretch of sidewalk will be in the right-of-way of Seven Hills Road adjacent to property owned by the City. To improve access to the Public Safety Building and the ground now used by the Parks Department, the City has a need to extend the sidewalk along this stretch of North Seven Hills Road. The low bidder is Rite-Way Excavating for a total cost of \$19,988.00 based on the unit prices submitted. A tabulation of bids is attached.

Legal considerations, if any: Normal execution of contract concerns.

Budget impact: Funding was set aside for this stretch of sidewalk in the approved FY2011 Prop S Budget.

Staff recommendation: Staff recommends execution of the RESOLUTION to support the awarding of the construction contract to the lowest qualified bidder, Rite-Way Excavating for \$19,988.00 based on their unit price bid.
