**AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND CITY CLERK TO EXECUTE A ILLINOIS
DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION (IDOT) RESOLUTION TO SHOW
CITY OF O'FALLON SUPPORT FOR A NEW SIDEWALK ALONG HIGHWAY
50 FROM LONG DRIVE TO VENITA DRIVE AND THE APPLICATION FOR
ILLINOIS DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION ENHANCEMENT
PROGRAM FUNDS (ITEP)**

WHEREAS, the City of O'Fallon, a municipal corporation, supports installing a new sidewalk along Highway 50 from Long Drive to Venita Drive, and

WHEREAS, there is no existing sidewalk along Highway 50 from Long Road to Venita Drive, and

WHEREAS, bicyclists and pedestrians need to have as a safer route to travel to and from the southwest quadrant of the City to the remainder of the City north of I-64, and

WHEREAS, the Illinois Department of Transportation has grant funds available on a limited basis for such pedestrian sidewalk projects under the ITEP grant program,

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY
COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF O'FALLON, ILLINOIS THAT:**

The City of O'Fallon hereby agrees with the addition of new sidewalk along Highway 50 from Long Drive to Venita Drive .

The City of O'Fallon authorizes its appropriate representatives to sign the application forms for ITEP grant funds for establishing new sidewalk along Highway 50 from Long Drive and Venita Drive.
