**AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND CITY CLERK TO EXECUTE A ILLINOIS
DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION (IDOT) RESOLUTION TO SHOW CITY OF
O'FALLON SUPPORT FOR NEW SIDEWALK AND PEDESTRIAN BRIDGE ALONG
MILBURN SCHOOL ROAD FROM PAUSCH ROAD TO RED HAWK LANE AND THE
APPLICATION FOR ILLINOIS DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION
ENHANCEMENT PROGRAM FUNDS (ITEP)**

WHEREAS, Milburn School Road is a busy collector route within the City of O'Fallon leading to O'Fallon Township High School, and

WHEREAS, there is no existing sidewalk along Milburn School Road from Pausch Road to Red Hawk Lane and pedestrians need an accessible route to travel to O'Fallon Township High School, and

WHEREAS, a pedestrian bridge will need to be constructed to provide pedestrian access along Milburn School Road across Ogle's Creek, and

WHEREAS, the Illinois Department of Transportation has grant funds available on a limited basis for such pedestrian sidewalk projects under the ITEP grant program,

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF
THE CITY OF O'FALLON, ILLINOIS THAT:**

The City of O'Fallon hereby agrees with the addition of new sidewalk along Milburn School Road from Pausch Road to Red Hawk Lane along with a pedestrian bridge to cross Ogles's Creek.

The City of O'Fallon authorized its appropriate representatives to sign the application forms for ITEP grant funds for establishing new sidewalk along Milburn School Road from Pausch Road to Red Hawk Lane along with a pedestrian bridge to cross Ogles's Creek.
