**AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND CITY CLERK TO EXECUTE A ILLINOIS DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION (IDOT) RESOLUTION TO SHOW CITY OF O'FALLON SUPPORT FOR THE PROJECT KNOWN AS MADISON/ILLINI BIKE TRAIL CONNECTOR AND THE APPLICATION FOR ILLINOIS DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION ENHANCEMENT PROGRAM FUNDS (ITEP)**

**WHEREAS**, the City of O'Fallon, a municipal corporation, supports installing a new bike/pedestrian trail to connect West Madison Street and Illini Trail and installing a new bike/pedestrian trail to connect West Madison Street and Mulberry Lane, and

**WHEREAS**, establishing bicycle access extending from West Madison Street to the Illini Trail will provide access to public roads and provide an alternate accessible route to Hinchcliffe School and Hesse Park, and

**WHEREAS**, establishing bicycle access extending from West Madison Street to Mulberry Lane will provide connection to existing public roads and provide an alternate accessible route to Hinchcliffe School and Hesse Park, and

**WHEREAS**, the Illinois Department of Transportation has grant funds available on a limited basis for such bike trail projects under the ITEP grant program,

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF O'FALLON, ILLINOIS THAT:**

The City of O'Fallon hereby agrees with establishing bicycle access connecting West Madison Street/Mulberry Lane to the Illini Trail and establishing bicycle access extending from West Madison Street to Mulberry Lane.

The City of O'Fallon authorized its appropriate representatives to sign the application forms for ITEP grant funds for establishing bicycle access connecting West Madison Street/Mulberry Lane to the Illini Trail and establishing bicycle access extending from West Madison Street to Mulberry Lane.
