ALL LEAGUE NOTES: Practices will begin in early April. Specific practice days will depend on the coach. Volunteer head coaches will get their registration fee refunded at the end of the season. Friend requests must be mutual to be guaranteed.

**Coach Pitch, Farm, Rookie, Minors, Majors, 1st/2nd Softball, 3rd/4th Softball** all will have a 12 game schedule. Ten games are guaranteed. Games will finish no later than July 1st. Rookie, Minors, and Majors typically play on Monday or Wednesday, and Saturdays. Coach Pitch, Farm, and Softball typically play on Tuesday and Thursday. Games will start in early May. Makeup games can take place on any day except Sunday.
