MINUTES COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT COMMITTEE 6:00 PM Monday, February 24, 2014

Minutes of a regular meeting of the Community Development Committee of the City of O'Fallon, held in the City Council Chambers, 255 S. Lincoln, O'Fallon, Illinois.

CALL TO ORDER: 6:30 PM

- Roll Call Committee members: Jerry Albrecht (chair), Gene McCoskey (vice chair), Jerry Mouser, Ray Holden, David Cozad, and Harlan Gerrish. Other Elected Officials Present: Herb Roach, Richie Meile, John Drolet, Kevin Hagarty and Michael Bennett. Staff: Walter Denton, Pam Funk, Jeff Stehman, James Cavins, Sandy Evans, Dan Bowman, Maryanne Fair, Justin Randall and Dale Funk. Visitors: Charlie Pitts, Georgia Hillyer, Clytie Zimmerman, Scott Schaefer, Steve Schaefer, Steve Lechner, John Hundley, Darren Taylor, Jim Luehers and Vern Malare.
- II) Approval of Minutes from Previous Meeting— All ayes. Motion carried.

III) Items Requiring Council Action

- A. <u>SEPA Lincoln Crossing Spring Fest (Motion)</u> Justin Randall briefed the committee on the proposed carnival to be held at the Lincoln Crossing shopping place. The committee discussed the past events at the shopping center. The committee recommended approval of the Special Event Permit with a vote of 6-0.
- B. Schaefer Autobody Center Use Variance (1st Reading) Dale Funk gave a brief overview of the use variance process and advised the committee not to take any additional evidence in the case. The committee questioned what they could discuss and what the committee's options were for the case. Mr. Funk indicated they could discuss the case as present d and could ask for clarification from the Zone Hearing Officer, or vote at the next council meeting on the case, with a two-thirds super majority necessary to overturn the Zone Hearing Officer's decision. The committee recommended the case be forwarded on to the full council without a recommendation with a vote of 6-0.
- C. <u>Liquor License Ordinance and Fees (1st Reading)</u> Maryanne Fair and Dale Funk gave a brief presentation on the changes to the ordinance, which include a combined Class B and Class C-2 and a Brew Pub license. Ms. Fair indicated the City of O'Fallon had not been reviewed since the codification of 1972. The committee discussed the increase in price for the current licenses. Staff indicated at the current time based on supplies, software and salaries the City of O'Fallon is losing money on issuing a liquor license. Staff also indicated the \$100 increase would not go into effect until May 2015, to provide ample notice of the increase in fees. The committee discussed the proposal. The committee recommended approval with a vote of 6-0.
- D. <u>Domino's Retail Center Planned Use (2nd Reading)</u> –The committee recommended approval with a vote of 6-0.

IV) Other Business

A) FY2015 Planning and Zoning Budget Proposal – Walter Denton gave a brief overview of the Community Development Department budget. The committee asked how the department was going to decrease the insurance requirement. Sandy Evans indicated this year there was a greater amount of detail that went into the insurance calculation for every department. The committee asked about the

increase in part-time hours. Staff indicated that the new role in which Community Development was reclassified to contain Planning and Zoning, Building and Codes and Economic Development and some increased presence in projects regarding economic development was the reason for the increase. Staff also noted both part-time positions are full-time positions. The committee discussed the request for a new truck. Jeff Stehman indicated the maintenance of the vehicle was begin to be costly with the wear and tear, even with 71k miles and noted the vehicle was 13 years old.

Cost Analysis for Liquor License Fee Increase

List of committees that have reviewed: Mayor Graham and City Attorney Funk, Community Development.

Background: The cost of business has increased since the last time the fees were increased per Ordinance 1534 in 1992.

Legal Considerations, if any: City Attorney Dale Funk has researched and reviewed.

Budget Impact: All fees will be modestly increased by \$100.00. Current revenue: \$22,400 – Proposed revenue: \$27,300

Staff recommendation: Approval.

Municipal Liquor Classifications and Fees Comparison

City of Belleville-

Class A, which shall permit the retail sale of alcoholic liquor for consumption on or off the premises where sold and not for resale in any form. The annual fee is \$550.

Class B, which shall permit the retail sale of alcoholic liquor for consumption on the premises of restaurants, but not for consumption off the premises of restaurants and not for resale in any form. The annual fee is \$550.

Class C, which shall only permit the retail sale of alcoholic liquor in sealed packages, but not for consumption on the premises of where it is sold. The annual fee is \$550.

Class D, which shall permit the retail sale of alcoholic liquor for consumption only on the premises where sold to be issued to a regularly organized club, such sales to be made only to the members of the club. The annual fee is \$400.

City of Collinsville-

Class A licenses shall authorize the retail sale of alcoholic liquors on the premises of any tavern for consumption on the premises. The annual fee is \$1500.

Class B licenses shall authorize the retail sale of alcoholic liquors on the premises in any restaurant that has fifty (50) percent or more of its gross revenue in each calendar month from

the operation of the licensed premises from regularly serving of meals, for consumption on the premises. The annual fee is \$1200.

Class B-1 licenses shall authorize the retail sale of alcoholic liquors on the premises in any restaurant that does not qualify for a Class B license for consumption on the premises, but that has twenty-five (25) percent or more of its gross revenue in each calendar month from regularly serving of meals. The annual fee is \$1500.

Class C licenses shall authorize the retail sale of alcoholic liquors in packages and not for consumption on the premises. The annual fee is \$1200.

Class D licenses shall authorize the retail sale of alcoholic liquors in packages and not for consumption on the premises where gasoline stations are attached as a secondary business operation. The annual fee is \$1200.

Class F licenses shall authorize the retail sale on the premises of alcoholic liquors in any club for consumption on the premises. The annual fee is \$800.

Class O licenses shall temporarily authorize current holders of valid Class B, B-1, E, F, and K licenses located in non-residential zoning districts, the retail sale for consumption alcoholic liquors outside of the premises on the property of the license holder, for a period of one (1) day per calendar year. Subclass (1) Supplemental License - \$300 annual fee for Class A license holders; \$150 annual fee for Class B and B-1 license holders.

Nonrefundable filing fee for initial application for license to sell alcoholic liquor - \$400.

City of Edwardsville-

Class A licenses authorize the retail sale of alcoholic liquor in the original package, but not for consumption on the premises where sold. The sale of alcohol is incidental to the sale of food and/or groceries. This includes but is not limited to, grocery stores and convenience stores. The fee is \$750.

Class B licenses authorize the retail sale of alcoholic liquor for consumption on the premises only. The fee is \$750.

Class C licenses authorize the retail sale of alcoholic liquor of all varieties for consumption on the premises, as well as the retail sale of alcoholic liquor in the original package for consumption off the premises. This includes but is not limited to, taverns, restaurants, and specialty shops that also sell packaged liquor. The fee is \$900.

<u>City of Fairview Heights</u>- The semi-annual fee for liquor licenses is \$500 + a \$4 Clerk fee. The annual fee is \$850 + a \$8 Clerk fee. Listed below are their classifications:

A Class A license shall authorize the retail sale on the premises specified of alcoholic liquor for consumption on the premises as well as other retail sales of such liquor.

A Class B license shall authorize retail sale of alcoholic liquor, but not consumption on premises where sold.

A Class C license may be issued to a club, which shall authorize the retail sale of alcoholic liquor on the premises of alcoholic liquor for consumption on the premises. Sales are to be made to club members only.

Village of Shiloh-

Class A – holder to sell retail alcoholic liquor for consumption on or off premises specified. The fee is \$400.

Class B- holder to sell retail alcoholic liquor for consumption on or off premises specified. The fee is \$500.

Class C – holder to sell alcoholic liquor in the original package only, on the premises specified in the license, for consumption off the premises. The fee is \$400.

Class D – holder to sell alcoholic liquor in original package only, on the premises specified, for consumption off premises. The fee is \$500.

City of Maryville-

Class A – Allowing for the consumption on premises. \$450

Class B – Allowing for the consumption on premises in clubs. \$450

Class C – Allowing for packages sales. \$450

City of Carbondale -

Class A1, A2, A3, B1, B2 – Allowing for consumption on premises (is determined based on occupancy and sales revenue multiplier – Minimum \$225 – maximum - \$2250

Class C1 – Packaged sales. \$2250

Class E - Fraternal – Consumption on premises - \$1125

ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 116 OF THE 2014 CODE OF ORDINANCES BY ESTABLISHING A NOT-FOR-PROFIT CORPORATION LICENSE CLASSIFICATION

WHEREAS, the City of O'Fallon has ascertained a need for a Not-For-Profit Corporation classification; and

WHEREAS, the current ordinance does not currently have a Not-For-Profit Corporation classification; and

WHEREAS, the O'Fallon City Council has determined that it is desirable and in the public interest to amend the O'Fallon Code of Ordinances with respect to a Not-For-Profit Corporation and to enact an amendment herein to Chapter 116 "Alcoholic Beverages" of the 2014 Code of Ordinances.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF O'FALLON, ST. CLAIR COUNTY, ILLINOIS;

<u>Section 1.</u> Chapter 116 Section 116.01 Definitions is amended by way of addition of the following:

NOT-FOR-PROFIT CORPORATION

For the purposes of this Code, a "Not-For-Profit Corporation" is defined to mean a corporation organized or registered under the laws of and in good standing with the State of Illinois pursuant to the Illinois General Not-For-Profit Corporation Act of 1986 (805 ILCS 105/101.01 et. seq.) and which entity was organized for the promotion of some common object or purpose, other than the sale and consumption of alcoholic liquors.

Chapter 116. Section 116.15 Classifications of Licenses is amended as follows:

<u>Section 2.</u> Chapter 116, Section 116.15, Classification of Licenses is amended by way of addition of the following:

(I) Class "G-1" license shall authorize a Not-For-Profit Corporation as holder thereof to sell, at retail, alcoholic liquor for consumption only on the premises where sold. Alcoholic liquor may be sold at retail for consumption on the premises at all hours chosen by the holder thereof, except between the hours of 1:00 a.m. and 5:00 a.m. when no sales of alcoholic liquor may be made. No person may consume, and no person other than the licensee shall possess or have, any alcoholic beverage upon the licensed premises more than one half (1/2) hour after the close of business for the retail sale of alcoholic beverage and before such business opens as allowed by the preceding, and the premises shall be vacated within one half (1/2) hour of the close of such business by all persons other than employees of the licensee then engaged in customary after-hour duties which relate to cleaning and closing of such business.

Class "G-2" license shall authorize a Not-For-Profit Corporation as holder thereof to sell, at retail, alcoholic liquor for consumption only on the premises where sold. Alcoholic liquor may be sold at retail for consumption on the premises at all hours chosen by the holder thereof, except between the hours of 2:00 a.m. and 5:00 a.m. when no sales of alcoholic liquor may be made; providing that a live band or such other live entertainment, as the Liquor Commissioner deems comparable, performs at such premises at least five (5) days each week. No person may consume, and no person other than the licensee shall possess or have, any alcoholic beverage upon the licensed premises more than one half (1/2) hour after the close of business for the retail sale of alcoholic beverage and before such business opens as allowed by the preceding, and the premises shall be vacated within one half (1/2) hour of the close of such business by all persons other than employees of the licensee then engaged in customary after-hour duties which relate to cleaning and closing of such business.

This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval and its publication in the manner provided by law.

SUBJECT: Special Event Permit – Keller Farms, Inc. "Sweet Corn Stand" at 1790 W. Highway 50

Project Summary

Applicant: Lindsey Keller for Keller Farms, Inc.

- Special Event Permit for a sweet corn stand from approximately June 20th to August 15th, 2014.
- Stand will be located at 1790 W. Highway 50 in front of the Metro-East Christian Fellowship Church as in previous years.
- Event will occur from 9:00 am to 6:00 pm daily.
- Customers will park on the designated parking area as shown on the attached site plan. No driveways will be blocked.
- Two "v-shaped" banners mounted on stakes will be placed near the front of the property as shown on the attached site plan. Dimensions are 3 ft x 8 ft.
- The applicant has not requested any special consideration from the City for this event.

Staff Recommendation: This request is consistent with previous year approvals by the Council for Keller Farms Sweet Corn Stand. Fire and Police had no issues with the request. Staff recommends approval of the Special Event Permit as proposed.



SUBJECT: Special Event Permit for Happy Day Tropical Sno Hut (MOTION)

Project Summary

Applicant: Dennis Cowden for Happy Day Tropical Sno

Location: 6000 Old Collinsville Road (Metro Lock parking lot)

Request permission to operate:

- Tropical Sno Concession April 2014 through October 2014
 - Snow cone stand, freestanding ice chest, 3 picnic tables
 - Occupy approximately 5 parking spaces along the southwest corner of the parking lot adjacent to Old Collinsville Road and Ashland Avenue intersection.
 - Temporary fence will be installed around the perimeter of the snow cone stand and picnic tables to provide separation from vehicular traffic.
- Hours of Operation: 7 days a week from 10:00 AM to 10:00 PM, adjusted as necessary.
- Number of Employees: 6-10 part-time employees
- Parking will be provided on site in the paved parking lot.
- The applicant is not requesting any special considerations from the City.
- The applicant has provided a letter from the property owner granting permission for the Special Event.
- The application is consistent with past Special Events applications.

Recommendation: The Police and Fire Departments reviewed the request and had no issues. Staff recommends approval of the Special Event Permit with the following conditions:

- 1. Hours of operation shall not extend past 10:00 PM.
- 2. Operation shall be situated on five parking spaces along the southwest corner of the parking lot adjacent to Old Collinsville Road and Ashland Avenue intersection and not on public ROW. A temporary picket fence shall be installed around the perimeter of the snow cone stand and picnic tables to provide separation from vehicular traffic.
- 3. The structure shall be anchored properly, and an electrical inspection shall be scheduled with the City for connection to nearby electrical source.
- 4. All temporary structures and facilities must be removed within 10 calendar days of the expiration of the special event permit.





We will need police to direct traffic during the race which will leave the Bank of O'fallon down South Lincoln to Pierce Blvd all the way to Frank Scott Parkway and then the runners will turn around to continue back down Pierce to South Lincoln and back to the Bank Of O'falllon. Signage will include mile markers at mile one, mile two and mile three, which will be posted on side of road. There will also be a water station at the turnaround on Pierce Blvd and Frank Scott Parkway. Parking will be at the Bank Of O'Fallon, across the street at Community Financial Building and open parking lot behind Community Financial Building. Race will carry on even if there is rain. The toilet facility will be at the Community financial Building. All runners/walkers will be given water at completion of the race. There will also be fruit, donuts, and snacks for each runners/walker. There will be a Chiropractor/Physcian on site to assess injuries, do stretching, and taping as needed.

We are expecting for our first year 300-500 participants running/walking in the race this year. With the addition of supporters and spectators, the event will draw well over 500 people to the race.
