DRAFT MINUTES HISTORIC PRESERVATION COMMISSION O'Fallon Museum/Downtown O'Fallon Meeting Room

Tuesday, Aug. 4, 2015 @ 6:30 p.m.

- 1. Roll Call: Krahulec, Hertich excused.
- 2. Approval of June meeting's minutes was deferred to the Sept. 1, 2015 meeting.
- 3. Public Hearings: None.
- 4. Discussion:
 - a. Possible Designations
 - i. Smiley Home (101 Dartmouth) Architectural description draft is completed and includes lengthy history and a story from a resident of the area. Still need signed application from property owner, plat from city, and photo. Package will be prepared for public hearing at Sept. meeting.
 - ii. St. Ellen Mine/Park work assigned to members: Spengler to research owner, Kampen to research workers, Sabella to research economic impact, Jordan to research United Mine Workers union, Hertich to research the communities of Alma and Carbon, Krahulec to research transportation used by workers and for coal itself.
 - b. Bank clock commemorative plaque: Debated whether to install it externally or internally. Some thought the 2' x 3' plan is too big to install on the outside. We decided to use copper engraving vice a stamped brass procudure. Spengler will prepare a mock-up of the plaque to demonstrate how it would look when installed.
 - c. St. Clare School Chapel/Lugge Center Building Visitor Dave Richey, representing St. Clare Parish, explained why the parish wants to raze the Lugge Center Building. The original designation of the church building erroneously included part of the property that the Lugge Center is on. The parish asked for clarification. After discussion with commission members that were present when the church was designated, it was determined that the Lugge Center was never intended to be designated. Jordan made a motion to exclude the Lugge Center building from the description of the church property, reflecting the original intent of the commission. Motion was seconded by Kampen, all ayes motion passed with no objections.
 - d. Bus tour in October: Randall showed draft of a program. Still need actor to portray Lou Allen.
 - e. Nomination of Officers: Spengler made motion to nominate current office-holders for next year, Kampen seconded, all ayes. Will vote at next meeting.
