STATEMENT OF ACTIVITIES TO FURTHER OBJECTIVES OF THE REDEVELOPMENT PLAN

Year Ended April 30, 2013

Menards

Menards is a retail hardware store that the City contracted with the developer to design, engineer, manage and finance construction of drives, sidewalks, sanitary sewer extensions, and other improvements. As of 4/30/2013, the project is 95% complete.

Parkway Lakeside Apartments

Parkway Lakeside Apartment Homes LLC is a Missouri limited liability company that the City has contracted with the developer to handle general repairs and maintenance in the floodway area. This includes but is not limited to grass cutting, installation and maintenance of a natural path, tree trimming, and removal of dead animals. As of 4/30/2013, there has been no activity.

Central Park Retail Center

Greenmount Retail Center LLC has contracted with the City to construct a 9,800 square foot retail center to be known as the Central Park Retail Center. The improvements include but are not limited to the construction/reconstruction/relocation of utilities, parking lot, curbs, street improvements and landscaping, storm water detention and drainage and other infrastructure improvements. As of 4/30/2013, this project is complete.

Central Park Plaza Condominiums

Central Park Plaza Condominiums LLC is a Missouri limited liability company that the City has contracted with the developer to handle site preparation, site improvement, mine remediation, construction of public works or improvements and water lines. As of 4/30/2013, there has been no activity.

DESCRIPTION OF AGREEMENTS REGARDING REDEVELOPMENT OF PROPERTY WITHIN THE PROJECT AREA

Year Ended April 30, 2013

City of O'Fallon - Menards

Between the City of O'Fallon and Menard, Inc., a Wisconsin corporation (the Developer), dated May 7, 2012 to provide tax increment financing for a portion of the development costs of a Menard's retail hardware store of approximately 162,000 sq ft under roof and approximately 28,000 sq ft of outside garden/shipping area. The project includes construction of certain public infrastructure and mine remediation.

Terms of the agreement provide that the City will reimburse the Developer for TIF eligible project costs incurred, to be paid from 70% of the tax increment revenue generated by the Menard's property, during the term of the TIF District, up to a maximum amount of \$4.9 million.

City of O'Fallon - Parkway Lakeside Apartments

Between the City of O'Fallon and Parkway Lakeside Apartment Homes, LLC (the Developer), dated May 7, 2012, to provide tax increment financing for improvement and maintenance costs of a floodway located on an outlot of the Parkway Lakeside Apartments, a residential development of approximately 240 units.

Terms of the agreement provide that the City will reimburse the Developer for floodway improvements and maintenance cost incurred, to be paid from tax increment revenue generated in the Central Park Plaza Redevelopment Project Area, during the Term of the TIF district.

<u>City of O'Fallon – Central Park Plaza Condominiums</u>

Between the City of O'Fallon and Central Park Plaza Condominiums, LLC (the Developer), dated May 7, 2012, to provide tax increment financing for a portion of the development costs of the Central Park Plaza Condominiums, a retail center of approximately 29,000 square feet. The project includes construction of certain infrastructure and mine remediation.

Terms of the agreement provide that the City will reimburse the Developer TIF eligible costs, which are to be paid from tax increment revenue generated within the Central Park Plaza Redevelopment Project Area, during the term of the TIF district, up to a maximum amount of \$1.25 million.

City of O'Fallon - Central Park Drive Retail Center

Between the City of O'Fallon and Greenmount Retail Center, LLC (the Developer), dated December 17, 2012, to provide tax increment financing for a portion of the development costs of a new retail center on Central Park Drive, a retail

center of approximately 9,800 square feet. The project includes construction of certain infrastructure and mine remediation.

Terms of the agreement provide that the City will reimburse the developer for TIF eligible project costs, which are to be paid from 50% of the tax increment revenue generated by the retail center property, during the term of the TIF district, up to a maximum amount of \$490,744.
