O'Fallon is the fastest growing city in Southern Illinois and one of the fastest in the entire St. Louis region. As we grow, we are constantly looking for ways to improve our city. Here are a few of the acknowledgments that have been given to O'Fallon in the past three years.

- In 2019, O'Fallon was ranked as one of the top 5% safest cities in Illinois.
- In 2019, we were ranked in the top 8% of most affordable cities in the U.S., of communities of populations from 25,000 to 100,000 people.
- In 2020, O'Fallon received the Southwestern Illinois Award for Growth & Development.
- In a biannual national survey, citizens gave the highest rankings ever to the city for honesty, treating residents fairly and overall confidence in city government.
- In 2021, the city's real estate tax rate was reduced to the lowest rate in 35 years.
- In the years 2017 to 2021, the city's debt reduced by more than \$20 million which is over 30%.

We are very proud of our schools which have received many acknowledgments through the years. They have consistently been ranked among the top performing districts in the state of Illinois. O'Fallon is at the epicenter for commerce and housing growth in the Metro East. As home of the new HSHS St. Elizabeth Medical Campus, O'Fallon is at the heart of the Metro East's "Medical Mile."
