<u>O'Fallon City Fest</u> will be held in the Community Park at 401 E. Fifth Street on Friday, August 16 & Saturday, August 17.


Parking on side streets will be restricted as indicated by temporary signs. Violators will be subject to tow at the vehicle owner's expense.

It's "Back to School" time and the O'Fallon Police Department would like to remind drivers that citations for **speeding in school zones** carry **heavier penalties** than standard tickets.

625 ILCS 5/11-605

In addition to a **mandatory court appearance**, violations of this Section are punishable with a *minimum* fine of \$150 for the first violation and a *minimum* fine of \$300 for the second or subsequent violation.

For the purpose of this Section, a school day begins at **7:00 AM** and concludes at **4:00 PM**.
