- 6" of water will reach the bottom of most
 passenger cars causing loss of control and possible stalling.
- · 1' of water will float many vehicles.
- 2' of rushing water can carry away most vehicles including SUV's and pick-ups.
- Road beds may be washed out under flood waters. <u>NEVER drive through flooded</u> roadways.
- Do not walk through moving water.
 6" of moving water can make you fall.
- Do not allow kids to play in or near culverts and ditches.

By using the SALAD technique, our providers enhance patient outcomes while adopting to new evidence based strategies. Using the SALAD technique helps mitigate complications with obscured vision during intubation as well as assuring correct tube placement. As seen above the crew is practicing SALAD intubation with our new UE scopes. Having the UE scopes on our units helps our medics provide the highest level of care to our community and it's visitors. Advanced airway management is one of the most critical life-saving skills as a paramedic can perform. Evidence shows video laryngoscopes greatly improve first chance success rate for airway placement.
