

Did you know that Illinois has a Fireworks Regulation Act? In 425 ILCS 30, the law prohibits the storage, sale or use of "fireworks," which it basically describes as anything that will explode. The law lists all types of cool fireworks names that are illegal, and also all types of cool names of things that are not considered "fireworks." The same law was adopted in 1992 by the City of O'Fallon as <u>Ordinance 137.42</u>.

Why bring this up you may ask...this a PSA that OPD will be actively enforcing fireworks violations with a zero-tolerance approach to violations. Anyone violating this act will be subject to the issuance of a citation.

Unfortunately, not all of our residents are able to enjoy fireworks the same way. For this reason, we ask for your consideration and adherence to the state and local ordinances.
