



O'FALLON EMS STOP THE BLEED TRAINING

During the months of September and October, O'Fallon EMS began a series of classes with staff at in-district schools to train them in the case of a mass casualty event. Stop the bleed is an initiative to provide time critical training to people in the case of bleeding. This class provides the public with knowledge and skills that can be used prior to EMS arrival. With hands on training, staff are trained to control bleeding through direct pressure, wound packing, and standard tourniquet application.
