**Subject:** RESOLUTION – Kaskaskia Engineering Proposal – Exit #21, I-64 Water Main Relocation

**List of committees that have reviewed:** Public Works.

**Background:** The plans for the new Exit #21 Interchange on I-64 have been approved and the alignment of the new section of Rieder Road calls for relocation of a City of O'Fallon water main there. As the City's water main is in an established easement, the interchange project will have to pay for the relocation. Kaskaskia Engineering is St. Clair County's Engineering consultant on the interchange, and City staff believe they are best qualified to work with the City and County on the relocation. The County asked the City to name a consultant to work with them on the relocation effort. City staff has been told by County staff that the Kaskaskia work in designing the relocation is either reimbursable to the City or will be paid by the County. The resolution supporting the Kaskaskia proposal is the City's indication to the County that Kaskaskia is an acceptable consultant for the work.

**Legal Considerations, if any:** Normal legal considerations when obtaining professional services.

**Budget Impact:** The County will be reimbursing the City of consultant costs or be invoiced directly. Terms of that arrangement are yet to be finalized.

**Staff recommendation:** Staff recommends acceptance of the proposal from Kaskaskia Engineering in the amount of \$25,170.00.
