**ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER  
116 OF THE 2014 CODE OF  
ORDINANCES BY ESTABLISHING  
A LICENSE TO ALLOW FOR THE  
CONSUMPTION OF ALCOHOLIC  
LIQUORS ON THE PREMISES AND  
TO SELL PACKAGED ALCOHOLIC  
LIQUORS FOR CONSUMPTION  
OFF THE PREMISES**

**WHEREAS**, the City of O’Fallon’s Alcoholic Beverages Ordinance does not provide for a license for both the retail sale of alcoholic beverages for consumption on the premises and the sale packaged alcoholic liquors off the premises; and

**WHEREAS**, the O’Fallon City Council has determined that it is desirable and in the public interest to amend the O’Fallon Code of Ordinances with respect to the sale of alcoholic liquor for consumption on and off the premises to encourage and promote such business activities and to enact an amendment herein to Chapter 116 “Alcoholic Beverages” of the O’Fallon Municipal Code.

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF O’FALLON, ST. CLAIR COUNTY, ILLINOIS;**

Chapter 116 Alcoholic Beverages is amended as follows:

Section 1. Chapter 116, Section 116.10, Classification of Licenses is amended by way of addition of the following:

(G) Class “E” licenses shall authorize a holder thereof to make sales at retail of alcoholic liquors for consumption on the premises with a seating capacity for twenty (20) or more patrons and to sell packaged alcoholic liquors for consumption off the premises.

Class “E” licenses shall authorize a holder thereof to sell, at retail, alcoholic beverages for consumption on the premises specified in such license and to sell packaged alcoholic liquors for consumption off the premises specified in such license at all hours chosen by the licensee except between the hours of 1:00 a.m. and 5:00 a.m. Monday through Friday, inclusive, and between the hours of 2:00 a.m. and 5:00 a.m. on Saturday and Sunday, when no sales of alcoholic beverages may be made. No person may consume, and no person other than the licensee shall possess or have, any alcoholic beverage upon the licensed premises more than one half (1/2) hour after the close of business for the retail sale of alcoholic beverage and before such business opens as allowed by the
