**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING
THE 2014 CODE OF ORDINANCES
OF THE CITY OF O'FALLON,
ILLINOIS, SECTION 51.080 OF
CHAPTER 51, SEWERS**

WHEREAS, Section 51.080 of Chapter 51, of the 2014 Code of Ordinances of the City of O'Fallon presently sets rates for surcharges for industrial users; and

WHEREAS, the wording of Section 51.080 of Chapter 51 of the 2014 Code of Ordinances of the City of O'Fallon, is in need of revision to update the charges to current industry standards and costs for treatment of industrial wastes discharged to a public wastewater treatment facility; and,

WHEREAS, in the interest of all rate payers served by the City's public wastewater treatment facility, Section 51.080 of Chapter 51 2014 Code of City Ordinances should be amended to its existing deficiencies.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF O'FALLON, ST. CLAIR COUNTY, ILLINOIS, AS FOLLOWS:

The existing Section 51.080 of Chapter 51 of the Code of Ordinances of the City of O'Fallon is repealed and replaced with the following at Paragraph (A) (2):

(2) *Surcharge for industrial users.*

(a) Effective ~~5-1-2010~~ **1-1-2015**, the following is the procedure for determining an industrial user surcharge:

1. Obtain representative B.O.D. and suspended solids concentrations in the waste. This may require 24-hour composite sampling for one or more days;

2. B.O.D. surcharge equals $(\text{B.O.D.} - 200) \times \text{number of million gallons used} \times 8.33 \times \0.22 per pound;
